Schedule

Friday and Saturday, April 20 and 21. Festival hours are 6-9:30 p.m. Friday, April 20 and 8 a.m.-5 p.m. on Saturday, April 21. Your booths must be taken down no later than 7 p.m.

Entry Deadline

Please return entry form by Thursday, March 1, 2012. Booth spaces are limited.

Location

The Philadelphia Ham Jam Arts Festival will be held in downtown Philadelphia.

Booth Space

Each booth will be 10x10. If you feel you will need more space than this, you must purchase additional space.

Entry and Booth Fee

Arts vendor spaces are \$75 for a 10x10 space if postmarked by March 1. Spaces will be \$100 after March 1. Please add \$10 if you need electricity. Electricity is on a first-come first-serve basis. An accepted application is a commitment to show and no refund will be made for cancellation after **March 1, 2012**. All cancellations must be in writing to the Director. No fee will be refunded in case of rain.

Artist Selection and Standards

The selection panel reviews applications on the basis of a photograph of your booth and of the items to be sold. Please include a list of ALL items you wish to sell. All items for sale will be reviewed. A letter, along with regulations, will be sent if accepted. The selection of vendors is up to the discretion of the Philadelphia Ham Jam Arts Festival Committee.

General Information

Vendors are responsible for all equipment used and trash generated by their setup. There will be limited electrical access. We ask if you have canopies or awnings they be secured by weights. No side flaps allowed on tents. Security will be provided in the festival area. Philadelphia Ham Jam Arts Festival, the Philadelphia Main Street Association, or the City of Philadelphia are not responsible for the loss or damage of any items. Each exhibit must be manned at all times during the festival hours. Please note that if you set up a booth on Friday, we are not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen merchandise. Each vendor is responsible for collecting Mississippi state and local taxes by law.
